### Mission:

As part of Pennsylvania's Tobacco Prevention and Control Program, our work is based on the Best Practices for Comprehensive Tobacco Control Programs published by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. The goals identified are designed to guide programs in their effort to significantly decrease tobacco related morbidity, mortality and economic costs.

### Goals:

- Prevent initiation of tobacco use among youth and young adults
- Promote quitting among youth and adults
- Eliminate exposure to secondhand smoke
- Identify and eliminate tobacco related health disparities

The Lung Association's Southcentral Tobacco Free Coalition (SCTFC) uses these goals to guide our work throughout the thirteen-county region. This includes the counties of Adams, Bedford, Blair, Cumberland, Dauphin, Franklin, Fulton, Huntingdon, Juniata, Lebanon, Mifflin, Perry, and York. We identify partner agencies that share our vision and have specialized skills in a particular area of tobacco control. SCTFC invests in programs that can foster sustainable change by embedding tobacco prevention and treatment of tobacco use dependency into existing programs and structures.

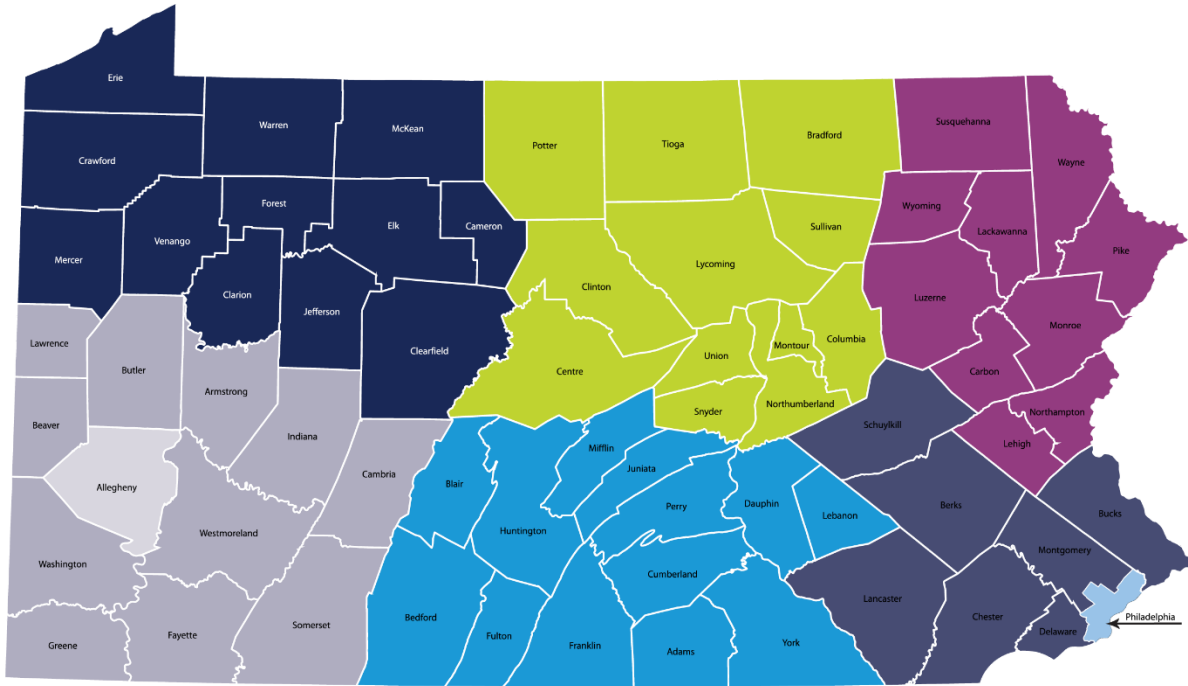
